Use before collection and delivery when wet weather could affect the route.

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Record the evidence you have, the owner of each open question and the next review time.

This record does not confirm weather safety, road permission, building access or service availability.

1. Forecast and decision point

Current warning or forecast summary

2. Road and building access

Lawful vehicle position and road condition

Building contact, entry slot or loading point

☐ Route review set

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Keep the route, load protection and pause decision visible as conditions change.

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3. Route and load protection

Wet route, floor, stair or entrance condition

Suitable surface protection or building requirement

Covered loading or handover point

Load protection and any item specific concern

☐ Route checked clear

☐ Covering plan checked

☐ Load plan rechecked

4. Pause or revised plan

What changed or could require a pause

Current decision: proceed, pause or request a revised plan

Decision owner and communication route
